BACKGROUND

Transparency International (TI) is the global civil society organisation leading the fight against corruption. Through more than 100 chapters worldwide and an international secretariat in Berlin, Germany, TI raises awareness of the damaging effects of corruption and works with partners in government, business, and civil society to develop and implement effective measures to tackle it.

The Transparency International Secretariat (TI-S) in Berlin is seeking a consultant with experience working with films and documentaries that focus on corruption and social justice.

The consultant will support with the design of impact campaigns and facilitate new partnerships with the film's teams.

The consultant will curate a short list of 3 upcoming film and documentaries that are preferably in the post-production phase and have a strong potential to become internationally known.

The consultant will assist the film team in designing an impact plan that includes the active participation of members of the TI & IACC Young Journalist network who would follow up with investigative journalism work on the selected area of focus.

The main areas of the documentaries are Freedom of expression, investigative journalism, dangers and challenges to investigative journalists, impact of their work and related topics.

Additionally, the consultant will design a small-scale pilot initiative bridging the work of film makers and the TI & IACC young journalists

OBJECTIVES

- To promote interdisciplinary collaboration between film and documentary makers, investigative journalists, and social justice advocates
- To support and maximise the impact of films and documentaries with a focus on social justice, and/or corruption
- To further support the impact strategies of award-winning films

EXPECTED DELIVERABLES AND TIMELINE

The successful candidate will:

- Brainstorm with TI team to refine the objectives and desired outcomes of working with film and documentary
- Research and deliver a curated shortlist of 3 high impact documentaries in the making, focusing on social justice
- Support or design the impact strategy of one film within the three shortlisted films.
- Work with selected members of the TI young journalists' network to add them to the impact strategy
- Document this work in a series of blog posts/interviews about the challenges and opportunities
 presented when connecting film and investigative journalism to advocate for change
- Suggest lessons learned and key recommendations for the full roll out of the small pilot initiative

All applications should be submitted in English, in electronic form, in accordance with the deadlines stipulated above. The Consultant is responsible for editing and quality control of language. The TI Secretariat retains the sole rights with respect to all distribution, dissemination, and publication of the deliverables.

SELECTION CRITERIA

The Consultant should have the following qualifications:

- Previous examples of related work
- Demonstrated capacity to reach out to an international network of filmmakers and related organisations
- Demonstrated experience in designing and/or supporting impact plans
- Over 5 years of relevant experience working with films and documentaries focusing on social justice
- Fluent oral and written English communication skills.
- Previous work with TI and the IACC Films work is a plus.

The Consultants should provide their estimated total fee as a lump sum or as standard daily or hourly rates as **gross inclusive of taxes and other charges**.

Consultants who are based in Germany and do not charge German VAT must confirm their small entrepreneur status.
